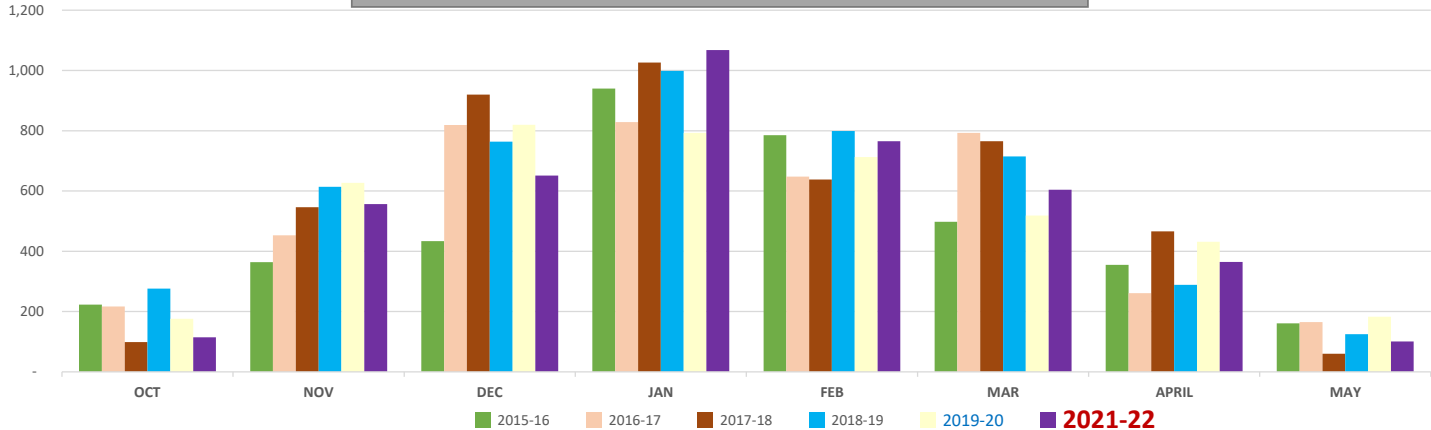


## CENTRAL PARK HEATING SEASON DEGREE DAYS OCT THRU MAY

Under NYC housing law, landlords need to provide heat from October 1 through May 31 during specific times and when the outside temperature drops to a certain point: During the day, the inside temperature must be at least 68 F everywhere in your apartment from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. if the outside temperature falls below 55 F.
